Topic Title: Little Bear and Me



For your home learning you can choose from the following tasks. **You must do the task in the centre first.** You can do the other tasks in any order.

Physical Development - Look for action rhymes on Youtube like Heads shoulders knees and toes. Join in with the actions. Look up Sticky Kids movement songs. Play outside every day.

Fine Motor Skills Look up dough gym on Youtube use some playdough or flour and water dough to do the finger exercises. Learn to cut with scissors. Practice threading things onto string. Do lots of mark making to develop pincer grip.

Communication and Language

Read bear stories, play pretending games with an adult, play turn taking games, follow verbal instructions to do tasks around the house or cook simple recipes.

Mathematics Count to 10 and back again while playing hide and seek. Count the stairs up and down. Count different amounts of toys. Say the number one more and one less up to 10. Go on a number hunt. Play dice games.

Literacy

Learn to write your name. Cut up each letter from your name and put the letters back in the correct order. Read a book every day.

Little Bear and Me

Have a teddy bear's picnic. Invite your toys to come. You could have pretend food or help to make real food. Write invitations for your party and decide on some party games to play at your party. Share out your food and drinks counting how many of each thing you need. You could make party hats or placemats for each guest. Put some photos on Tapestry of this and any other activities you do at home.
